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Intrinsic vs. Extrinsic Motivation Explained

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Both extrinsic motivation and intrinsic motivation drive human behavior. There are several key differences between motivation that comes from external rewards and the kind that is driven by an individual's genuine interest, including the influence of each type on a person's behavior and the situations in which each type will be most effective.

Differences Between Extrinsic and Intrinsic Motivation

The results of descriptive statistics and correlation coefficients demonstrated that the females had a higher level of intrinsic motivation while the males had a higher level of extrinsic motivation. Besides, the degree of correlation between intrinsic motivation and attainment of L2 speaking skill was statistically higher among the females. Also, t-test results indicated a statistically significant difference in the intrinsic/extrinsic type of motivation between the male and female students.

Relationship Between Intrinsic/Extrinsic Motivation and L2 ...

In intrinsic motivation, the person enjoys the task, but in extrinsic motivation, the person gives more emphasis to the awards and rewards received on accomplishing the task. Intrinsic motivation is driven by a person's own desires and needs. Contrastingly, the extrinsic motivation is driven by other sources, usually another person.

Abstract. Investigating the relationships between student's intrinsic (IM) and extrinsic motivation (EM) and their effects is critical for offering a more complex perspective on which types of motivation promote optimal learning and achievement. The goal of this study was to analyse IM and EM as two independent forms of motivation or, alternatively, as two opposite poles of a continuum ranging from a poor (extrinsic) to a good (intrinsic) form of motivation.

Linear regressions were conducted with intrinsic academic motivation, interpersonal conflict, and their interaction as independent variables to predict depression and stress. Results showed that intrinsic academic motivation was negatively, while interpersonal conflict was positively, associated with depression and stress. Moreover, the interaction was significant: negative association of “intrinsic academic motivation and depression” and that of “intrinsic academic motivation and ...

Relationship Between Intrinsic Motivation and ...

Intrinsic motivation is closely linked to the fundamental desire to learn and develop new skills. The psychological factors that are the underlying drivers of intrinsic motivation include the need to be in control of one's behavior, the need to feel proficient in one's tasks, and the need to develop meaningful relationships with others. In the case that these fundamental needs are satisfied, high levels of intrinsic motivation drive athletes to participate in sports.

Originally, it was considered that extrinsic motivation refers to behaviours performed in the absence of self-determination and thus which could only be prompted by external contingencies. In order to consider the relationship between reward and intrinsic motivation for learning we shall review some initial researches and theoretical approaches.

Originally, the theory differentiated between intrinsic and extrinsic motivations were. Later, a continuum with varying degrees of individual autonomy was proposed (Deci & Ryan, 2000). Intrinsic motivation represents the most self-determined or autonomous behavior regulation by inherent interest, enjoyment and satisfaction.

Self-Determination Theory: Intrinsic and Extrinsic Motivation

Self-determination theory (SDT) is a macro theory of human motivation and personality that concerns people's inherent growth tendencies and innate psychological needs.It is concerned with the motivation behind choices people make without external influence and interference. SDT focuses on the degree to which an individual's behavior is self-motivated and self-determined.

Based on the result of the study, it was found that OCB had a significant mediating effect on the relationship between intrinsic motivation and job burnout (Standardized β = -0.400, $p<0.005$).
